Glass Partitions

This Design and Installation Guide provides a comprehensive and straightforward approach to installing glass partitions, following the best practices and standards in the industry. It is intended to serve as a quick reference and should be used alongside detailed manufacturer instructions and guidelines. Now, please proceed to the detailed installation steps provided below to ensure a successful and safe installation process.



Tools Required:

- Measuring tape
- Pencil and marker
- Level
- Drill and drill bits
- Screwdriver
- Rubber mallet
- Suction cups for glass handling
- Safety gloves and goggles
- Adhesive and sealant
- Aluminium channels and fittings which can be <u>purchased here</u>

Step-by-Step Instructions:

1) Planning & Measurement

- Measure the area where th glass partition(s) will be installed.
- Mark the positions on the floor, ceiling, and walls using a pencil and level to
- ensure accuracy.
- If you need any assistance with this, please send us your opening measurements with a rough sketch and we can assist you by providing visual designs.

2) Preparing the Channels

- We usually supply a base channel for the bottom which has a removable front cover and a U-shaped head channel for the top and side.
- We also supply gaskets to hold your glass in place within the channel.
- Cut the aluminium channels to fit the measured dimensions.
- Drill holes in the channels for screws, ensuring the spacing is consistent We recommend starting 75/100mm from the end and repeating every 500mm.



3) Installing the Base Channel

- Position the floor channel on the marked line.
- Drill holes into the floor through the channel.
- Secure the channel to the floor using appropriate screws and raw plugs.

4) Installing the Head Channel

- Align the ceiling channel with the floor channel.
- Use a level to ensure it is perfectly aligned.
- Repeat the drilling and securing process as done with the floor channel.

5) Installing Head Channels on Side Walls (if required)

- If the glass partition is to be attached to a wall, follow the same pricess to install the wall channels.
- Ensure the channels are aligned vertically with the floor and ceiling channels.

6) Placing the Glass Panel

- Insert packers (not supplied) to prevent glass from touching the screwss.
- With suction cups, carefully lift the glass panels.
- Insert the top edge of the glass into the head channel and then move the bottom of the glass into the base channel.
- $\circ\,$ Insert the front cover onto the base channel.
- Using a rubber mallet, gently tap the glass into place if necessary.

7) Securing the Glass Panels

- Insert gaskets into the channels for stability.
- $\circ\,$ It is possible to use silicone to secure the glass further.

8) Installing Doors (if applicable)

- If doors are included in the partition, follow manufacturer instructions to install door fittings and handles.
- Attach the door to the hinges and ensure it swings smoothly.

9) Final Adjustments and Cleaning

- Check the alignment of all panels and adjust as needed.
- Clean the glass and channels to remove any fingerprints or marks.
